Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility.

We are also happy to announce the reopening to essential caregivers and visitors. As you know, since mid-March, Crosbyton Nursing and Rehab restricted visitation to only essential personnel pursuant to federal and state guidelines to help mitigate and prevent the spread of COVID-19.

While CMS and HHSC recognized the importance of social distance and physical separation to help keep our residents safe at the onset of this pandemic, they feel we are now at a point we can open our facility to family and loved ones. Knowing the critical role family members and outside caregivers have in the care and support of residents, and knowing how they advocate for the residents, we look forward to welcoming essential caregivers and visitors who provide that support to our residents.
