Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility.

Crosbyton Nursing and Rehab continues to follow CMS and CDC guidance to prevent the transmission of COVID-19. We are also following the State and Local direction. Because we serve an extremely vulnerable population, CMS does not recommend opening our facility to visitors (except for compassionate care situations) until Phase Three.

With the need for extra precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19, Crosbyton Nursing and Rehab has been working hard to protect our residents. The lack of visitors and need for social distancing has changed how we entertain our residents on a daily basis. The Activity Director has been coming up with creative ways our residents can still have fun while staying safe.

Of course, residents are staying in their rooms a lot more, and those who are able have been doing individual activities like puzzles, movies, reading, coloring and word games. We do hallway bingo, which is a fan favorite. We also do "sittercise" outside so residents can social distance while enjoying some sun. A lot of our activities also include food, such as ice cream, cake, watermelon and a variety of snacks.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
